Modernization Phases

Phase 1: Nevada Civil and Criminal Information System (NCCIS) Portal
Completed

Phase 2: Warrant Entry and File Validations Systems
Completed

Phase 3: Point of Contact Firearms Program – Federal Firearms Licensees (FFL), Disposition of Firearms (DOF), and Civil Name Check Program (CNC)
Completed – January 28, 2025

Phase 4: Computerized Criminal History (CCH), Civil Applicant Program (CAP), and Concealed Carry Weapon (CCW)
Scheduled for late May 2025

Phase 5: Portal Search
Scheduled for late August 2025

Remaining Phases

Phase 3 - New Capabilities: January 28, 2025

- **FFL** - Automated capabilities for non-fingerprint Brady Act – Federal Firearms Licensees background checks.
- **DOF** - New Disposition of Firearms background capabilities to law enforcement agencies enabling National Instant Criminal Background Check System (NICS) checks for releasing firearms from evidence.
- **CNC** - Automated capabilities for Nevada’s Civil Name Check Program transactions.

Remaining Phases

Phase 4 - New Capabilities: May 2025

- **CAP** - Online servicing capabilities for Civil Applicant Program businesses to support fingerprint submissions for employment and licensing.
- **CCW** - Electronic Concealed Carry Weapons application submissions.
- **PID** - Automated capabilities for individuals submitting Personal Identification requests.
- **CCH** - Replaces the Computerized Criminal History Systems, which will expand the processing capabilities of criminal history inquiries and improve the efficiency of the state's processes.

Remaining Phases

Phase 5 - New Capabilities: August 2025

- **Portal Search** - Provides a comprehensive, state-wide information technology system to facilitate the immediate, seamless, and comprehensive sharing of information between all appropriate state and local criminal justice agencies, departments, boards, and commissions.
- This will improve officer and public safety through improved accuracy, quick access, and completeness of criminal justice information.

Remaining Supporting Projects

NCJIS Projects' Status

- The NCJIS Modernization Program continues to make progress. The Program began on July 1, 2019, and is scheduled for completion by June 30, 2025.
- The NCJIS Modernization Program comprises 33 projects with a status as follows:
 - 12 completed to be formally evaluated and closed out
 - 21 supporting technology projects in progress and on-track
 - Five additional interface integration projects with criminal justice agencies.
