## Modernization Phases

**Phase 1:** Nevada Civil and Criminal Information System (NCCIS) Portal  
**Completed**

**Phase 2:** Warrant Entry and File Validations Systems  
**Go-live scheduled for October 21, 2024**

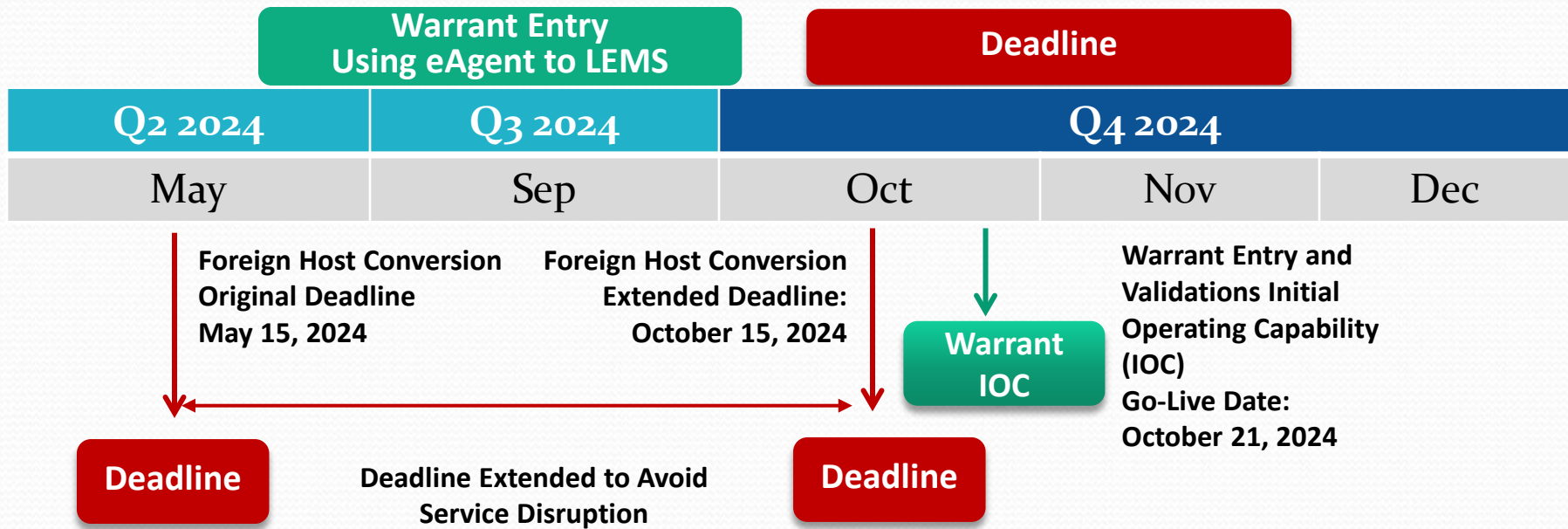
**Phase 3:** Brady, Disposition of Firearms, and Civil Name Check Program  
**Scheduled for late January 2025**

**Phase 4:** Computerized Criminal History (CCH), Civil Applicants Program, and Concealed Carry Weapon (CCW)  
**Scheduled for late March 2025**

**Phase 5:** Portal Search  
**Scheduled for mid-2025**

# Go-Live

## Pre-IOC Agency Preparation

- **Training:** TAC/ATACs notified to ensure operators have received training on eAgent, the new warrant system, and the new validation system.
  - Next training dates: **October 10, 2024 and October 17, 2024**
- **NCJIS Warrants Update:** TAC/ATACs are ensuring that NCJIS warrants include the corresponding NIC number by **October 16, 2024**.
- **Validations:**
  - Complete October's Nevada Criminal Justice Information System (NCJIS) and National Crime Information Center (NCIC) validations by **November 4, 2024** using the Peak Performance platform in the Criminal Justice Information System (CJIS) Validations Application of the NCCIS Portal.
  - If the record is not validated by **November 30, 2024**, the NCIC System will retire the record and generate a **\$.P. Purge Failure to Validate Notification on December 1, 2024**.

# Go-live

## Warrant Entry Freeze

- **Freeze Period:** The NCJIS warrant database in JLink enters a query-only freeze period from **October 17, 2024**, at **11:00 PM** (2300 hours) through **October 21, 2024**, to allow for migration to the LEMS Cloud.
- **Manual Recordkeeping:** Entry agencies are encouraged to track all eWarrants, NCJIS warrants, and NCIC warrants during the freeze period, plus two contingency days.
- **NCJIS Warrants During the Freeze:**
  - Entries or modifications will not be allowed.
  - Only clears or cancels will be allowed.
- **NCIC Warrants During the Freeze:**
  - Wanted/warrant records can be entered into NCIC for critical officer and public safety purposes.



# Warrant Entry and Validation

## Go-Live – Communication Timeline

1. **September 24 and 26, 2024:** Change Ambassador informational meetings.
2. **September 30, 2024:** Warrant Entry and Validations Systems Go-live announcement.
3. **October 1, 2024:** NCJIS and NCIC file validations instructions.
4. **October 11, 2024:** Redelivery of announcement and instructions.
5. **October 15, 2024:** Final reminders of warrant entry freeze.
6. **October 21, 2024:** Go-live notification and resumption of warrant entry.
7. **October 23, 2024:** Notification that manual tracking of warrants/eWarrants is no longer required.

# Foreign Host Migration

- **Key Points Communicated:**

- Deadline to avoid increased risk of losing FH access: **October 15, 2024**
- The current onboarding schedule is dependent on the above factors and is subject to change. Any agency that has concerns with how they are prioritized should contact their FH Liaison. Agencies are encouraged to onboard as soon as possible to avoid loss of access.

- **Consequences of Missing the Deadline:**

- Potential loss of FH access
- Potential inability to query transactions on Mobile Device Terminals (MDTs) or other devices with FH access
- **Temporary Workaround:** Officers can query directly through eAgent or have requests run through their communication centers, which may overwhelm these centers. This workaround is similar to processes used during temporary system outages or upgrades.
