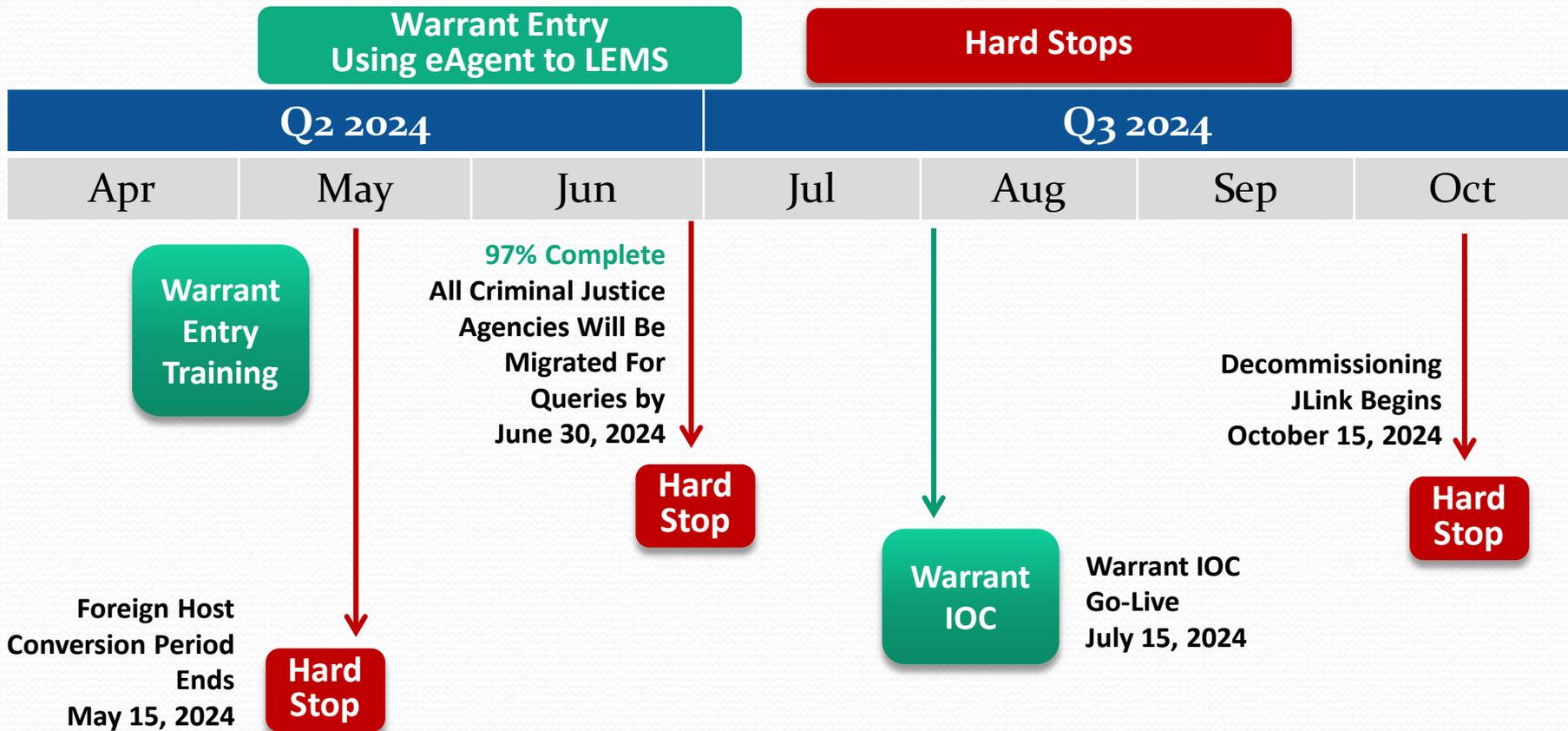

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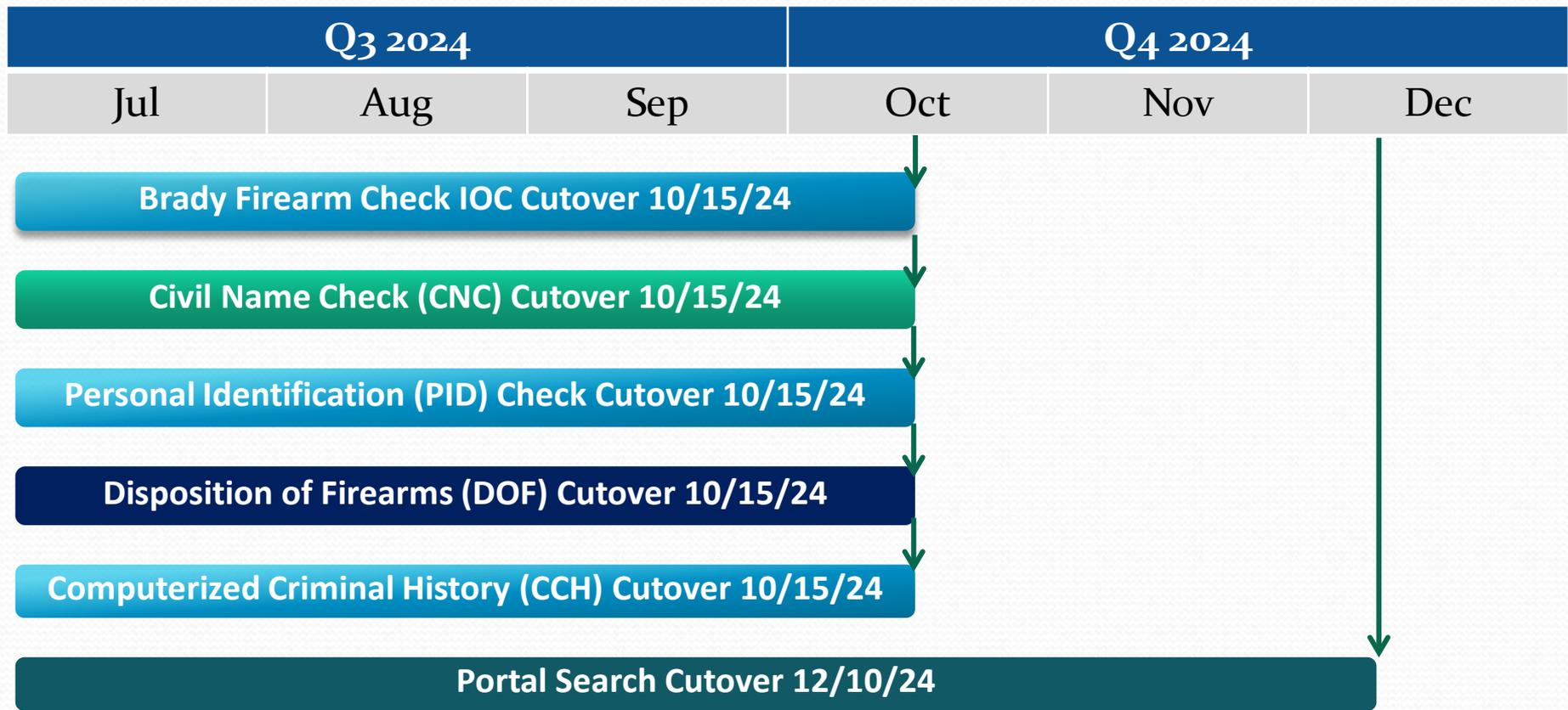
## Rollout and Hard Stops

# Official Go-Live

## Phase 2

- **Active.** Phase 2 is underway with the preparation, training, and go-live of warrant entry agencies for the new Law Enforcement Message Switch (LEMS) and eAgent *for inquiry*.

**Until such time that the new Warrant System Initial Operating Capability (IOC) is cut over to production on July 15, 2024, all entry agencies will continue to perform NCIC entry using JLink, but agencies can use eAgent for Inquiry functions.**



# Official Go-Live

## Phase 3

- **On deck.** Scheduled for late 2024.
  - Replace the State's Computerized Criminal History (CCH) system—the central repository for Nevada criminal history records.
  - Roll out the new Disposition of Firearms (DOF) background check capability to law enforcement agencies, which will provide functionality to process a National Instant Criminal Background Check System (NICS) background check when releasing firearms from an agency's evidence vault.
  - Provide new automated capabilities to Nevada's civil businesses. This deployment will create efficiencies and provide a faster, more efficient way to perform Point of Contact Firearms background checks and both fingerprint- and non-fingerprint-based background checks required by law.

# Agency Preparation Training

- The NCJIS Modernization Team held in-person training sessions in Carson City, Elko, Las Vegas, and Reno starting April 23, with the final sessions currently taking place through early June 2024. This training covers the new warrant entry and validation processes.

# Foreign Hosts

- Impacted agencies are requested to complete their new FH connection by **May 15, 2024**, to avoid possible service disruption.
- The reasons for this deadline are:
  - DPS resource constraints. The NCJIS Mod Team will be fully engaged in the following:
    - CCH system
    - DOF solution
    - Civil application testing and deployment
    - User acceptance testing (UAT) for multiple interfaces
    - Training and go-live for criminal justice agencies on new solutions
    - Training and go-live for civil business customers on new solutions



# Foreign Host Update *(continued)*

Listed below are DPS' efforts to get Foreign Host (FH) agencies connected:

- March and April 2021 – Individual meetings with each FH agency to inform and answer questions
- September 2021 – FH information in the September 2021 newsletter
- November 2021 – Start of ongoing communication regarding the OCJA NCHIP Grant availability to cover interface update expenses
- May 2022 – FH preparation survey with key information
- June 2022 – Continued reminder on OCJA NCHIP Grant availability and that agencies need to work with their vendors to upgrade
- September 2022 – FH outreach effort coordinated and launched by Karla Mead (ongoing)
- June 2023 – FH connection onboarding documents delivered, providing steps for FH configuration, testing, and production deployment
- January 2024 – Foreign Host Onboard Meeting technical sessions for agency and vendor IT
- March 2024 – Foreign Host Technical Information Session; initiated live chat channel via MS Teams for agency IT and FH vendors

# Helpful Tips and Reminders

## The following information has been provided to your agency:

- Existing eAgent users may notice some changes to the response formats as interfaces are moved off JLink and onto the Law Enforcement Message Switch (LEMS). The main difference is that the fields may be in different locations. Information is not changing.
- Warrant entry agencies should be working on adding the NIC number to each NCJIS warrant record, if a corresponding National Crime Information Center (NCIC) warrant exists.
  - If this process is not completed prior to the final data migration, it could result in NCJIS warrants being duplicated.
- Agencies will be informed by email from the Office of the Chief Information Officer (OCIO) on the exact migration process and Warrant IOC date.
- Agencies may not add the same NIC number to more than one State warrant. A NIC number can only be used on one NCJIS warrant at a time. We recommend adding it to the most egregious warrant.
