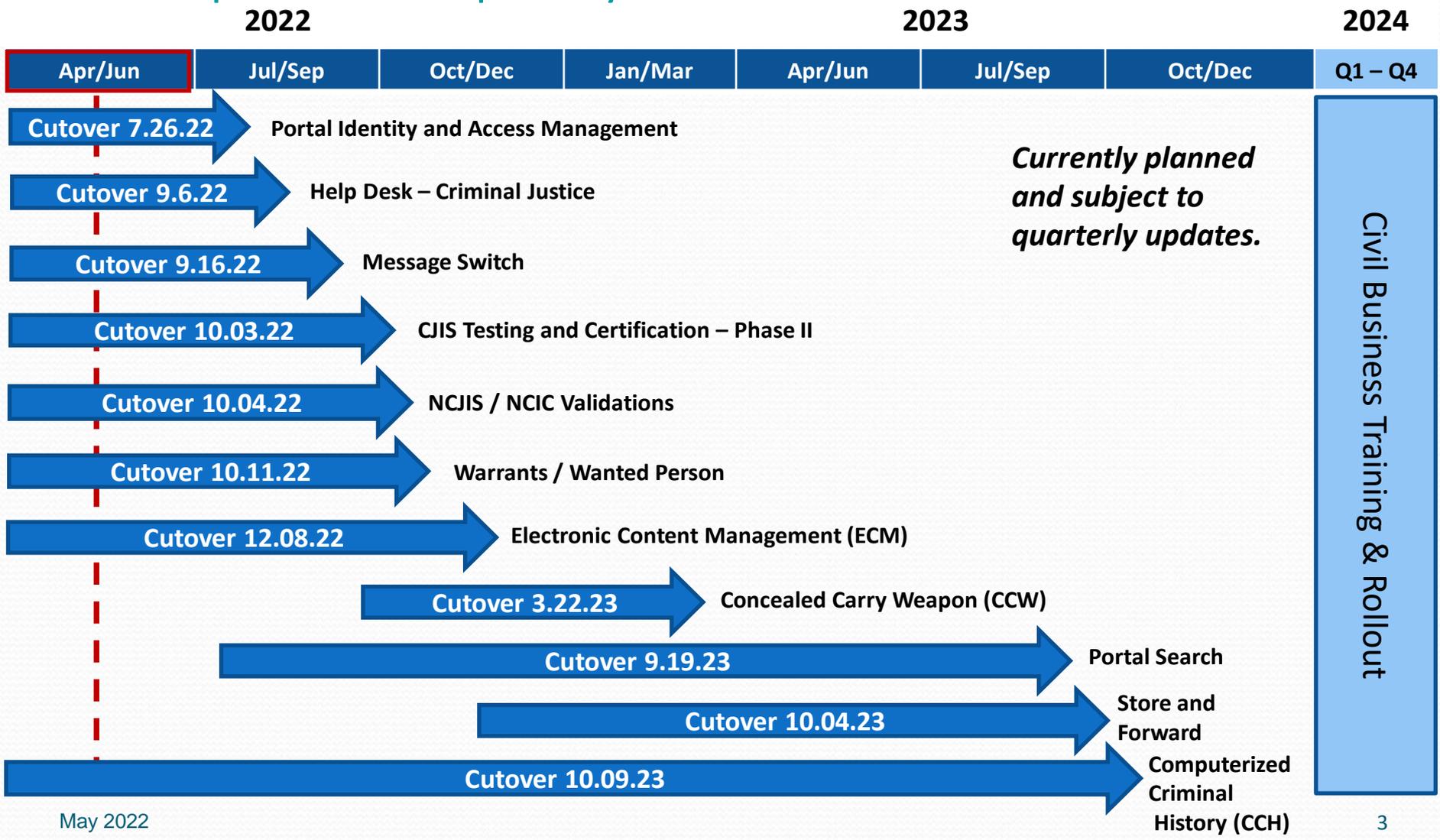

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Training and Rollout Plan

Planned Approach

This first rollout concerns agencies that sign in through the NCCIS portal to access the Law Enforcement Message Switch (LEMS).

Training and rollout sequence:

- I. DPS Mod Team and NCJIS Compliance Unit
- II. User Acceptance Testing (UAT) – pilot agencies
- III. Agency user training and rollout

Note: User training will be delivered on site or through MS Teams as determined by the NCJIS Mod Team.



Training and Rollout Plan

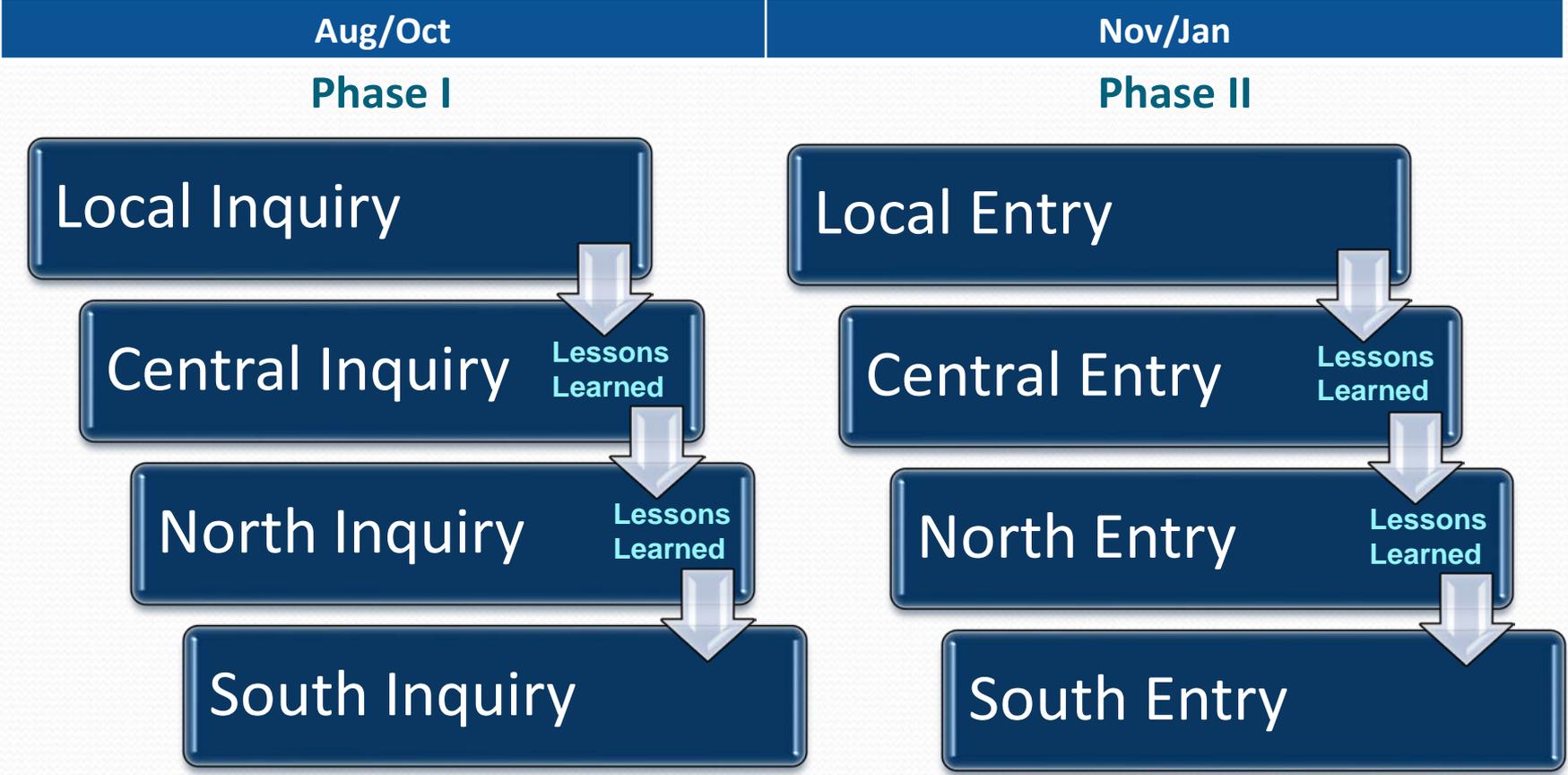
Planned Approach *(continued)*

- Training and rollout will start with local agencies in closer proximity to Carson City.
- Rollout will be slow and steady to gain efficiencies from lessons learned.
- Rollout will happen in two phases:
 - I. Inquiry agencies
 - II. Entry agencies

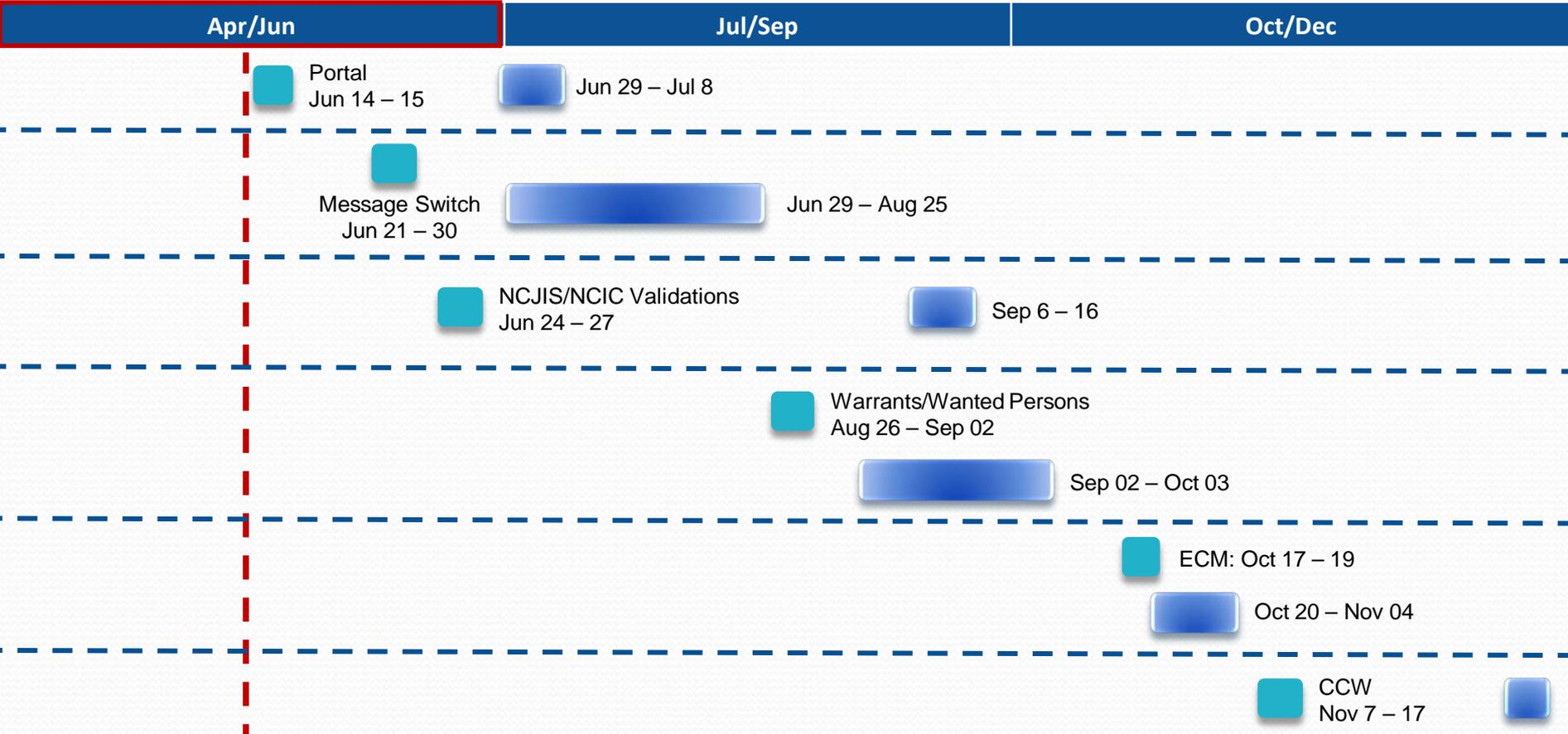

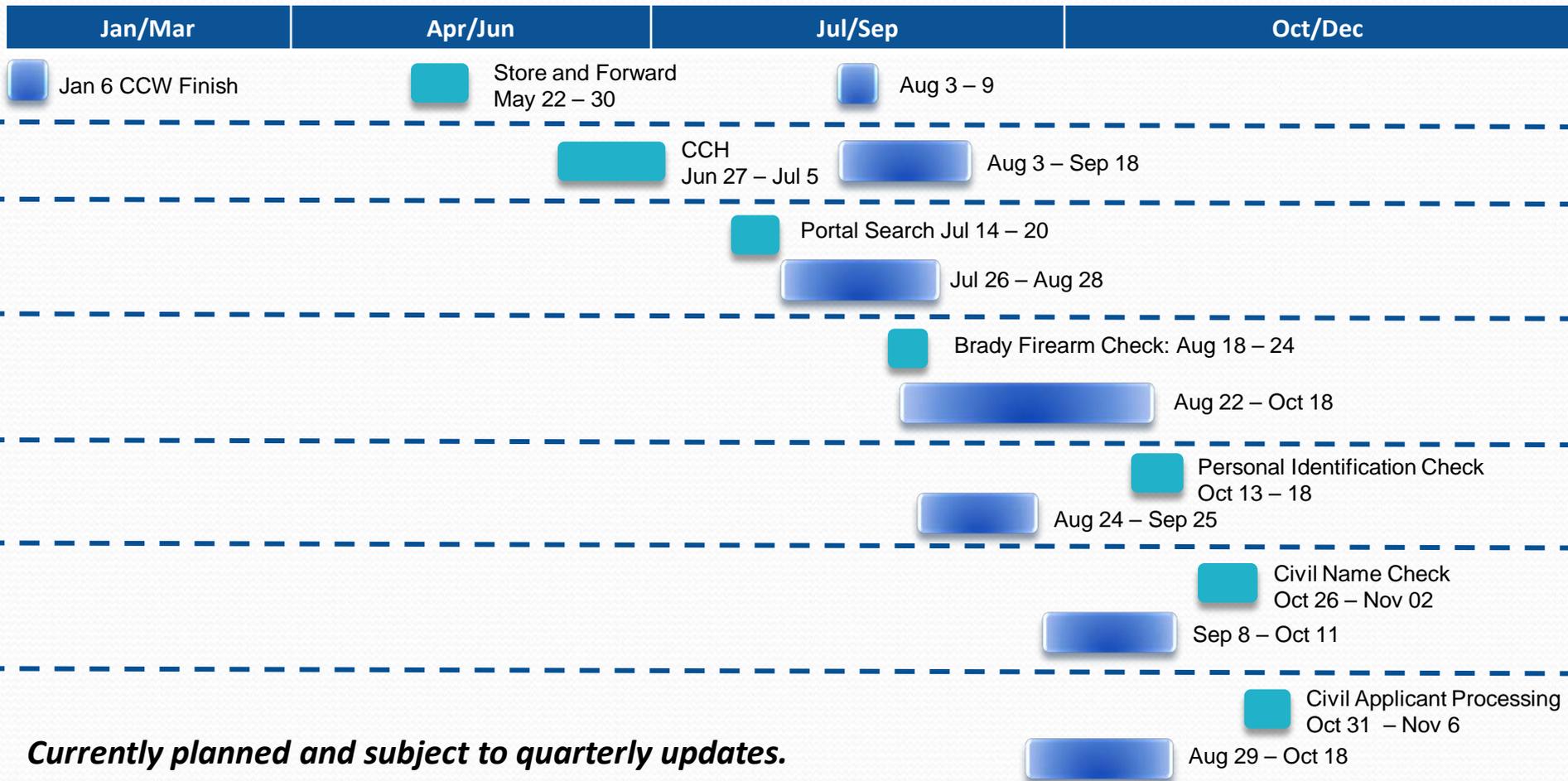

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Helping Agencies Prepare

Transitioning your Agency

Schedule

Contact Agency Change Ambassador to start the transition phase *60 days* before the scheduled migration date.



Prepare

Deliver a checklist to the transitioning agency. Hold planning meetings to help the agency prepare.



Train

Coordinate and launch TAC training. Training may be on site or online through Teams. Materials will be provided.



Go Live

NCJIS Mod Team will provide support to migrated agencies after go-live according to newly streamlined Help Desk processes.



Helping Agencies Prepare

Agency Tasks

Prepare your agency for the coming transition by ensuring:

- Windows 95 or 7 devices are upgraded to a current Windows operating system.
 - Use of an operating system of Windows 10 or newer is necessary to access the NCCIS portal.
- Users are NCJIS-certified or recertified at least two months prior to go-live.
- All users, including temporary workers, have a unique e-mail.
